



# CONSTITUTION OF THE KINGDOM OF THE FREE KINGS

A Democratic Monarchy Where Every Citizen Is a  
King, and Leaders Are Servants





## **PREAMBLE**

We, the Kings of the Kingdom of the Free Kings, born sovereign and equal in dignity, declare that leadership shall be an act of service, not authority.

Recognizing the inherent royalty of every human being, we establish this Constitution to uphold justice, ensure freedom, promote welfare, and create a nation where every King thrives and every Servant governs with humility, responsibility, and transparency.

With this vision, we institute a Democratic Monarchy where the people are Kings and the leaders are Servants, under the guidance of the Chief Servant.



## **CHAPTER I – THE KING (THE PEOPLE)**

### **Article 1 – Status of Kings**

- All citizens shall be titled King.
- No discrimination shall exist between Kings on the basis of race, religion, gender, origin, wealth, or belief.
- Being a King is a birthright and cannot be revoked except in cases of treason as defined by law.



## Article 2 – Rights of Kings

All Kings shall enjoy the following rights:

- **Right to Equality:** Every King is equal in dignity and status.
- **Right to Freedom:** Speech, belief, movement, expression, and assembly.
- **Right to Vote:** To elect Servants and remove Servants peacefully.
- **Right to Protection:** The Servant Council must safeguard every King.
- **Right to Justice:** Fair and impartial judgment.
- **Right to Privacy:** Personal life shall remain inviolable.
- **Right to Property:** Private property is protected.



## **Article 3 – Duties of Kings**

### **Kings shall:**

- Respect fellow Kings.
- Protect the dignity of the realm.
- Contribute to the nation's growth.
- Contribute to the nation's growth.
- Avoid harming others or the environment.





## **CHAPTER II – THE GOVERNMENT OF SERVANTS**

### **Article 4 – Nature of Government**

- The government is a Servant Council.
- The purpose of government is to serve the Kings, not rule them.
- All Servants are publicly accountable.



## **Article 5 – Chief Servant**

- The highest servant of the Kingdom is the Chief Servant.
- The Chief Servant shall represent the nation, protect its values, and guide its Servants.
- The Chief Servant may propose laws, veto harmful laws, and lead national strategy.
- The first Chief Servant is Shameem Khan, Founder of the Kingdom.



## **Article 6 – The Servant Council**

The Council shall include:

- Servant of Justice
  - Servant of Foreign Relations
  - Servant of Finance
  - Servant of Welfare
  - Servant of Peace & Security
  - Servant of Development
  - Any additional Servant roles as created by law.

## **Article 7 – Duties of Servants**

Servants must:

- Serve all Kings without bias.
  - Offer full transparency in all decisions.
  - Protect the Constitution.
  - Never use their position for personal gain.
  - Resign if the Kings lose confidence in them.

## **CHAPTER III – LAW & JUSTICE**

### **Article 8 – Judicial System**

- Courts shall be known as Courts of the Kings.
- Judges shall be titled Servants of Justice.
- Every King must receive fair and equal justice.

### **Article 9 – Criminal Law Principles**

- No one shall be punished without a fair trial.
- Torture, humiliation, and degrading punishment are prohibited.
- Laws must be clear, public, and just.





## **CHAPTER IV – NATIONAL SYMBOLS**

### **Article 10 – National Flag**

- Royal Blue + Gold Crown + White Stripe.
- Represents Kingship, Purity of Service, and Unity.

### **Article 11 – National Emblem**

- Three golden crowns within a circular crest.
- Motto: “Servant Leadership for All Kings”.

### **Article 12 – National Anthem**

Title: **“All Kings, One Nation”**

## **CHAPTER V — ECONOMY & RESOURCES**

### **Article 13 — Currency**

- Official currency: **CROWN (CRN)**.
- Digital and physical forms permitted.

### **Article 14 — Economic Principles**

- Free and ethical economy.
- Protection against exploitation.
- Kings may own private businesses freely.



## **CHAPTER VI – CITIZENSHIP**

### **Article 15 – Citizenship Rules**

- Anyone may apply to become a King.
- Citizenship may be granted by the Chief Servant.
- Dual citizenship is allowed.

### **Article 16 – King Identity**

- All Kings receive a King ID Card.
- Passports may be issued for ceremonial or travel recognition efforts.



## **CHAPTER VII – DEFENSE & SECURITY**

### **Article 17 – Principles**

- The Kingdom shall maintain peace above all.
- Any defense force shall be titled Servants of Peace.
- No Servant may use force against a King except by lawful order.



## **CHAPTER VIII – FOREIGN RELATIONS**

### **Article 18 – International Policy**

- Peace with all nations.
- No interference in others' internal matters.
- Diplomatic missions may be established symbolically.



## **CHAPTER IX – AMENDMENTS**

### **Article 19 – Amendment Process**

- The Chief Servant may propose amendments.
- Amendments require approval by a majority of the Kings (vote).
- The Constitution must always protect:
  1. Human dignity
  2. Equality of Kings
  3. Servant leadership

## **CHAPTER X – SUPREME CLAUSE**

### **Article 20 – Final Declaration**

This Constitution is the supreme law of the Kingdom of the Free Kings.

All Servants are bound to it.

Kings remain forever sovereign.
